You should present a recent research paper (published within last 5 years) on any subject of condensed/soft matter physics from one of the following journals: Science, Nature, Nature Materials, Nature Chemistry, Nature Nanotechnology, Nature Methods, Nature Physics, Nature Photonics (NOT Nature Communications, NOT Scientific Reports, NO Review Articles ONLY Articles (Nature, Nature Materials...), Letters (Nature, Nature Materials...), Research Articles (Science), Report (Science)). You're expected to discuss papers with professors every 2 weeks for 1 1.5 hours. More details will be announced in class.
