課程簡介：

殖民活動並不非近代歐洲首創，而是人類長久歷史發展的活動之一。本課程將針對考古學對殖民活動及其相關影響的研究進行專題討論。我們將從定義出發，界定討論範疇，而後從研讀後殖民考古學的理論基礎出發，討論後殖民理論如何影響考古學檢視過去相關議題研究，以及如何引導出新的取向。我們也將討論考古學（如同許多其他學科）學科發展與近代殖民主義活動的關聯。

本課程為討論課，文獻閱讀、課堂報告與帶討論為主要課程活動。閱讀文獻將涵括地中海、美洲、亞洲、及大洋洲的殖民活動。此外，本課程將包含兩次田野訪查，將台灣的例子帶入討論。學生須自訂題目撰寫研究論文，並於期末分享。

課程目標：

1. 熟悉考古學對殖民活動的定義以及相關研究範疇
2. 認識後殖民主義的思維如何影響考古學研究方法與詮釋
3. 反思台灣考古學相關議題的可能研究方向
4. 練習製作解題書目 (annotated bibliography)

評量：

1. 解題書目與閱讀提問 30%

解題書目有助於快速瀏覽已閱讀的大量文獻，是有志學術耕耘者的好幫手，為了培養於閱讀後製作解題書目的習慣，請學生於每週的指定閱讀中擇一製作其解題書目。此外，請附上 1-2 個針對個別文章的問題，於課堂前一天五點以前寄給授課老師與當週負責導讀的同學。當週導讀的同學不需繳交。（什麼是解題書目？<http://terms.naer.edu.tw/detail/1679208/>）

2. 課堂導讀與討論 30%

每週輪流負責導讀，同學課前除了閱讀指定書目之外，需要（1）對作者背景做一些調查作為導讀的一部份，（2）整理學生提問帶領討論。

3. 期末報告 40%

請同學自行擇題。可以是某主題的深入討論、或是某主題與學生個人研究的初步對話。請同學於第五週前與授課老師確認報告主題，期末口頭發表並繳交書面報告。期末報告繳交期限為 6/18/2019 下午五點，遲交一天扣 2 分，6/21/2019 後不再受理。
