課程說明	<p>The course offers sources and illustrations of classical myth and legends, and commentary that emphasizes the anthropological, historical, religious, sociological, and economic contexts in which the myths were told. It also provides a cultural context so that readers can see how mythology has influenced the world and how it continues to influence society today. By studying the myths of the ancients primarily through the literary works in which they are preserved, students sustained interest and kindled imagination throughout the history of Western culture. The contemporary adaptations are also discussed in the perspective boxes including video games, films, and young adult novel series such as Rick Riordan's <i>Percy Jackson</i>, etc.</p>
